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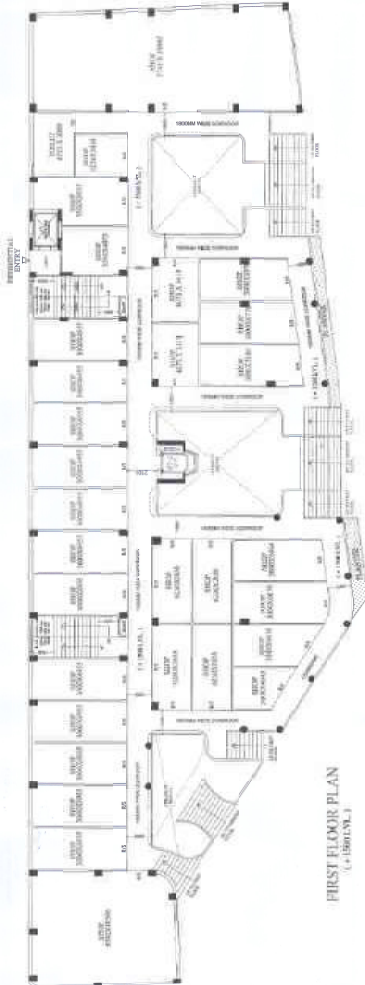
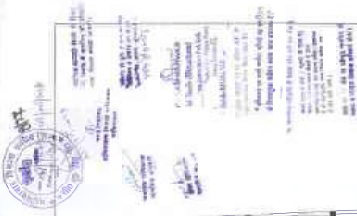
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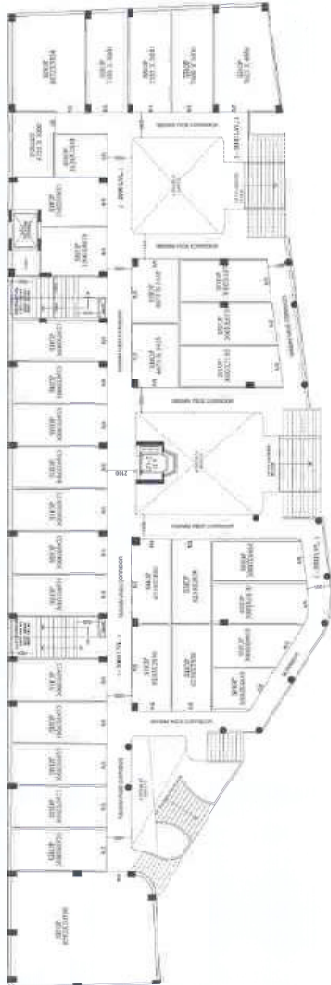
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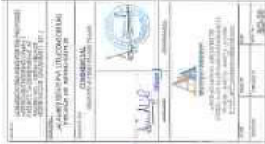
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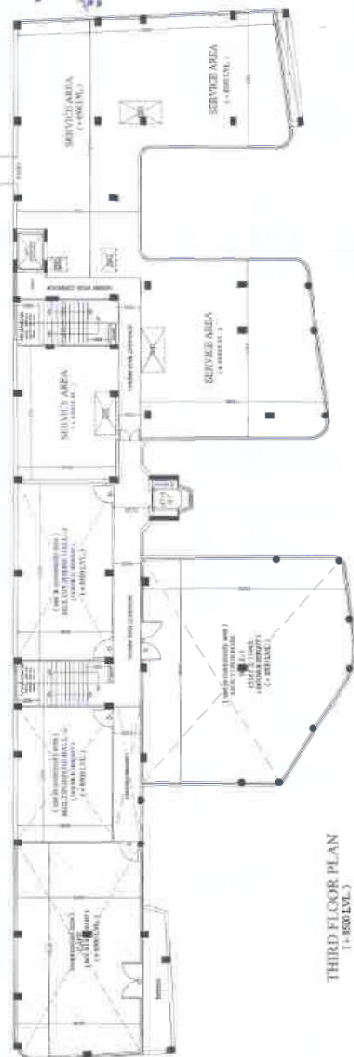


FIRST FLOOR PLAN
(+100 FIN.)

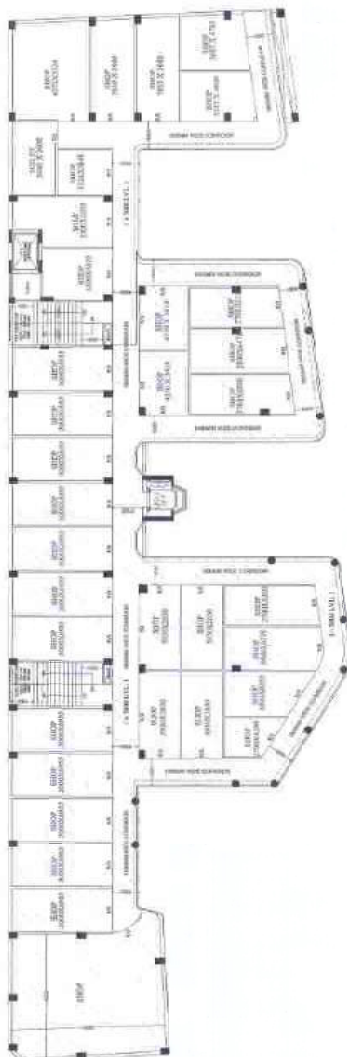


GROUND FLOOR PLAN
