5. For any change in above mentioned parameters, it will be mandatory to obtain Consent to Establish again. No further expansion or modification in the plant shall be carried out without prior approval of U.P. Pollution Control Board.

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2. You are directed to furnish the progress of Establishment of plant and machinery, green belt, Effluent Treatment Plant and Air pollution control devices, by 10th day of completion of subsequent quarter in the Board.

3. Copy of the work order/purchase order, regarding instruction and supply of proposed Effluent Treatment Plant/Sewerage Treatment Plant /Air Pollution control System shall be submitted by the industry till 09/06/2023 to the Board.

4. Industry will not start its operation, unless CTO is obtained under water (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1981 from the Board.

5. It is mandatory to submit Air and Water consent Application, complete in all respect, four months before start of operation, to the U.P. Pollution Control Board.

6. Legal action under water (Prevention and control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 may be initiated against the industry With out any prior information, in case of non compliance of above conditions.

Specific Conditions:

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

1. The CTR is issued for the construction project having built up area less than 20000 sq.m. In any case built up area exceeds this CTR will be automatically be revoked.
2. The Construction project shall provide facility for collection of environmental samples and samples of trade and sewage effluents, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated points and shall pay to the Board for the service rendered in this behalf. STP shall be as per proposal submitted.
3. Whenever due to any accident or other unforeseen act or even, such emission occur or is apprehended to occur in excess of standards laid down, such information shall be forthwith reported to Board, concerned Police Station, office of Directorate of Health Services, Department of Explosives inspectorate of Factories and Local Body. In case of failure of pollution control equipments, the production process shall be stopped.
4. The Construction project shall provide an alternate electric power source sufficient to operate all pollution control facilities installed to maintain compliance with the terms and conditions of the consent. In the absence, the construction project shall stop, reduce or otherwise, control production to abide by terms and conditions of this consent.
5. Construction project shall ensure all the pollution control measures during establishment phase, so that no environmental problem arises to the common people.
6. The Construction project shall provide the records/documents/log book regarding productions, raw material, natural gas, electricity and water consumption etc and also co-operate the visiting officers of the Board.
7. The Construction project shall not change or alter the quantity, quality, rate of discharge or the mode of the effluent/emissions or hazardous wastes or control equipments provided without previous written permission of the Board. The Resort/Hotel will not carry out any activity, for which this consent has been granted or without prior consent of the Board.
8. The Construction project will have to install or adopt rain water harvesting system to maintain a ground water level by charging rain water and will have to obtain NOC from Central Ground Water Authority for consumption of ground water in manufacturing process or in other activities.
9. The Construction project shall provide facility for collection of samples of sewage effluent, air emissions and hazardous waste to the Board staff at the terminal or designated point and shall pay to the Board for the services rendered in this behalf.
10. The firm shall strictly comply with the Water Act, 1974 and Air Act, 1981 and environmental protection Act 1986 and Municipal Solid Waste (Management & Handling), Rule, 2000 and E-Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 2011.
11. The Construction project shall provide proposal of disaster management plan within one month.
12. Construction project shall develop green belt/Miyawaki as per UP govt. guidelines.
13. CTE is issued based on the undertaking that no felling/cutting of trees to be done during construction phase of the project. As per ITZ direction, legal action shall be undertaken in case of violation if any.

Please note that consent to Establish will be revoked, in case of, non compliance of any of the above mentioned conditions. Board reserves its right for amendment or cancellation of any of the conditions specified above. Industry is directed to submit its first compliance report regarding above mentioned specific and general conditions till 09/07/2022 in this office. Ensure to submit the regular compliance report otherwise this Consent to Establish will be revoked.
