Sub.: Regarding Consent to Establish/Operate.

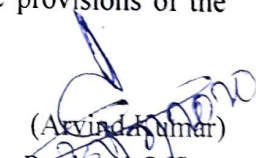
Sir,

With reference to your aforesaid application dated 29.07.2020 in this office for Consent to Establish (CTE) of M/s. S.J.P. Global Ltd. (Shri Radha Golf Sector-2) (Approx. 17 Acre) at Mauja-Anuor, Goverdhan, Mathura. Your Site devoloping with not more then 5000 Sq. Meter (Builtup Area) falls under White Category as per classification of U.P. Pollution Control Board dt. 09-01-2019 at Sr. No.-75. Now as per latest Board policy. White Category industries are exempted from consent management (CTE/CTO). The exemption from obtaining consent of the Board under the provisions of the Water (Previsions & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & Air (Previsions & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and hazardous waste management rules, 2016 for the white category of industries, in the unit satisfies the following conditions:-

1. That the developer of prescribed site should follow the guide lines laid down by U.P.P.C.B., C.P.C.B. S.I.E.A. & Other Authorities, from time to time.
2. That the investment should not be more than Rs. 5 Crore (For Construction).
3. The developer will estiblish S.T.P., Municipal Solid Waste disposal site, Rain water harvesting and proper green belt on the said site.
4. The developer will ensure the complance of orders passed by Hon.'ble Suprem Court, Hon.'ble NGT, CPCB, TTZ Authority, SIEA & UPPCB from time to time .
5. The developer will not installed DG set of capacity more the 15 KVA (acoustically enclosed).
6. All such units identified as "Producers" under the provisions ot the plastic waste management rules, 2016.

In case developer is found to create conditions that generate any type of pollution or if there is any objection from the surrounding community and if on verification it is found that such objection has some substance, the Board shall be at liberty to take legal action against the industry under the provisons of the Water (Previsions & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 & Air (Previsions & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 or enviornment (Protection) Act, 1986, as considered appropriate.

In case of failure of the condition and provisions mentioned above, UP Pollution Control Board reserve its right and powers to take action against the unit under the provisions of the Environment Protection Act of 1986.
